II. ONGOING ACTIVITY UPDATES

1. **RAMP:** Crystal has expended approximately 2/3 of the RAMP budget, and will provide an invoice when the full \$2,100 is spent.
There is a need to educate servers to take a closer look at photo IDs. 95% of non-compliance is occurring because the server/doorman is not looking thoroughly at the ID.
2. **BARNSTORMERS:** Crystal has arranged for the Anheuser-Busch Clydesdale horses to parade in downtown Lancaster City. Beginning and ending at Clipper Stadium. Thursday, August 4, 3-6pm. The Police Taxi will be parked at the stadium.

4. **WEBSITE/FACEBOOK UPDATES**
 - a. **Facebook Dashboard: March:** 172 followers; (up 2 from last month). 25 posts, 2,250 contacts
Emphasis was on St. Patrick's Day and information on DUI-D; education and enforcement.
April: 8 posts = 544 contacts. Demographics are 63% female, 37% male. 4% age 18-24, 22% age 25-34, 37% age 35-44, 22% age 45-54, 13% age 55 and over.
 - b. **Website:** No report.
5. **POLICE TAXI:** At the request of PennDOT, Barb presented a workshop featuring the Police Taxi (how it came about, the process, and the unique partnerships) at its annual statewide Traffic Safety Conference in April.
Upcoming events are: Hempfield's "Cops 'n Rodders" (May 14), Solanco High Schools "Act Out Loud Rally (May 16-20), Manor Township PD's "National Night Out" (August 2), Clydesdale Parade (August 4), Camp Cadet (August 15), and Montgomery Township PDs "Autumn Fest" (October 1).
The taxi was recently inspected. In all, it only needed headlight adjustment, a repair for an exhaust leak, and emission inspection. The total bill was \$78.32.
Barb was asked by PennDOT to speak at its annual statewide Traffic Safety Conference in Philadelphia. She was asked to serve on a panel of speakers to address community collaboration and unique partnerships. The collaboration she was specifically asked to talk about was the Police Taxi
