PENNSYLVANIA'S ZERO TOLERANCE LAW

It is illegal to consume, possess, purchase, attempt to purchase, or transport alcohol under the age of 21. The penalty for an underage drinking conviction is a fine of up to \$500 and driver's license suspension.

It is illegal to provide alcohol to a minor (even if you're the parent). The fine for a first offense is \$1,000 – all subsequent offenses carry a fine of \$2,500.
