

Conferences & Trainings:

RAMP Trainings:

The Council underwrites the cost of many of the Responsible Alcohol Management Program trainings conducted in Lancaster County. This is an invaluable education for owners and operators of licensed beverage establishments, and their servers. Trainings can be conducted in person by a certified trainer, or on-line.

Lunch & Learn:

We bring the training to where you work! Everyone's lives are already jam packed without us adding to your busy schedule. We will conform our training to fit your needs, time frame, topic, and all. And, if necessary, we can provide light refreshments.

Fatal Vision Goggles:

Available with a Council-provided presentation, or on a loaner basis, the goggles simulate a .18 BAC level. Although the participant's cognitive skills are still intact, his/her vision, judgement and depth perception are distorted to simulate impairment. A great learning tool that provides an ideal teaching moment for both youth and adults.

Police Taxi:
